**INTERNATIONAL BIG SUR MARATHON 2025**

**7 days, 6 nights**

The course runs from Big Sur to Carmel along the scenic Route 1, the first nationally designated scenic highway.



### Day 1 - Thursday, April 24: Montreal to San Francisco

- In the morning, meet your guide at Montreal airport and **depart for San Francisco on a direct Air Canada flight.**
- Arrival at San Francisco airport and private transport to **Muir Woods National Monument for a visit through the Sequoia forest** (included).
- Private transfer to your **4\* Hotel Zoe Fisherman's Wharf** (or similar) and check-in.
- The rest of the evening and dinner are free to explore the beautiful **Fisherman's Wharf area.**

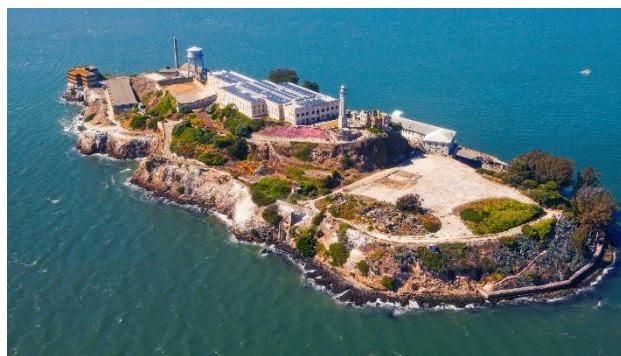

The **hotel restaurant, Pescatore**, serves fresh seafood and Italian specialties that you can enjoy outside.*



### Day 2 - Friday, April 25: City tour of San Francisco and Alcatraz

- Breakfast at the hotel.
  - **Morning tour with a French-speaking guide to see the main attractions of San Francisco.**
  - Return to **Fisherman's Wharf for lunch.**
- OPTION: Alcatraz tour in the afternoon (price to be confirmed)**
- Return to the hotel and free afternoon/evening.

## Day 3 - Saturday, April 26: San Francisco to Monterey

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Morning departure for **Monterey** by private transport on the **scenic Pacific Coast Highway 1!**
- Arrival at **Hotel Abrego, 3\*** (or similar), leave your luggage at the concierge, and head to the **Monterey Conference Center**, a 15-minute walk from your hotel. **Pick up your marathon bibs and see the exhibitions.**

*The Health & Fitness Expo will be held on Friday, April 26 from 12 PM to 6 PM, and Saturday, April 27 from 9:30 AM to 6 PM. On Saturday, there will be a full day of free running clinics starting at 11 AM in the Steinbeck Ballroom on the third floor of the Monterey Conference Center.*

- Check-in and free afternoon.

Meals are available in the **Abrego lounge**, serving a selection of **light dishes and a wide choice of locally produced wine and beer**. The hotel also features a heated outdoor pool and is just a **15-minute walk from the Monterey Conference Center**.*





## Day 4 - Sunday, April 27: BIG SUR MARATHON & BOSTON 2 BIG SUR CHALLENGE

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **Around 5:30 AM - Marathon runners board the private coach for the group directly in front of the hotel.** Only runners are allowed on board.
- 6:00 AM - Departure by bus to Big Sur, the starting point of the marathon.
- **End of the marathon in Carmel**, shuttles from the finish village will depart between 9:30 AM and 2:00 PM, bringing runners back to Monterey.
- **Upon return, enjoy an exclusive cocktail for your group to celebrate your achievement!**
- Rest of the day free.

*\*\*Transport to the starting line is subject to authorization from the marathon organization. In the event of refusal to travel with our own transport, runners will have to take the organization's buses.*

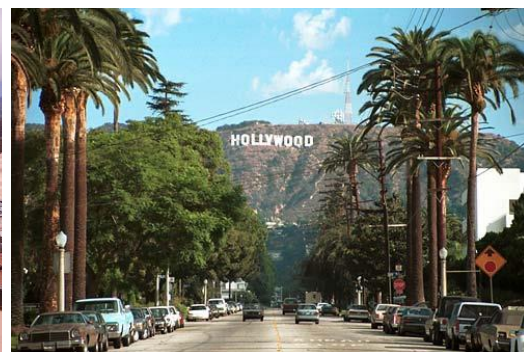
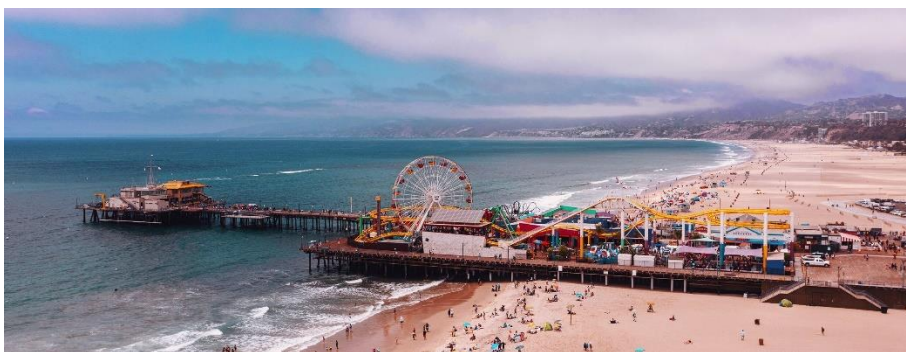

## Day 6: Tuesday, April 29: San Luis Obispo to Santa Monica and Los Angeles

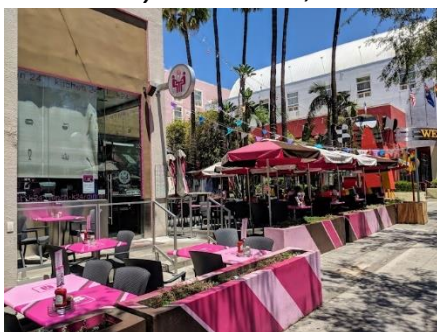
- Breakfast at the hotel.
